It's hard to know what to do with them for the best, and how to incorporate them into your scheme. So I've been doing a little hunting around to find a few different options:

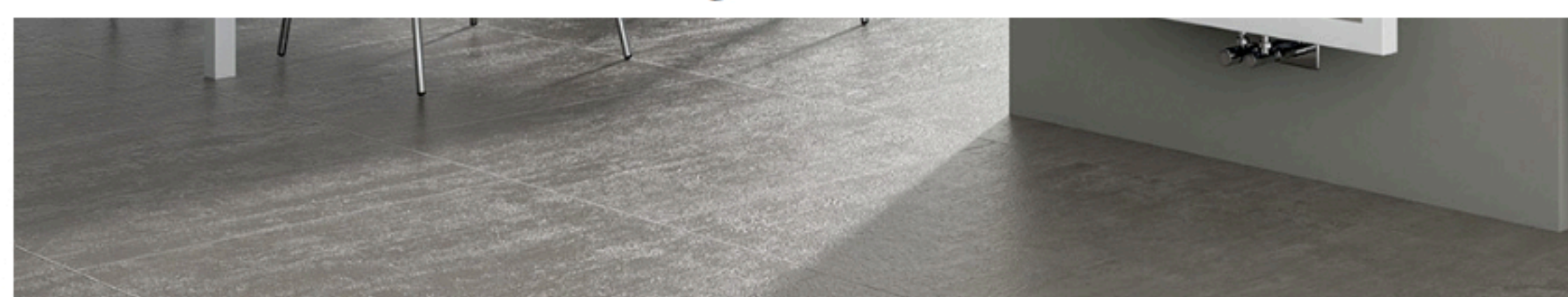

There are many choices available, something to suit every taste and design aesthetic, so take your time, do your research and find one you love.

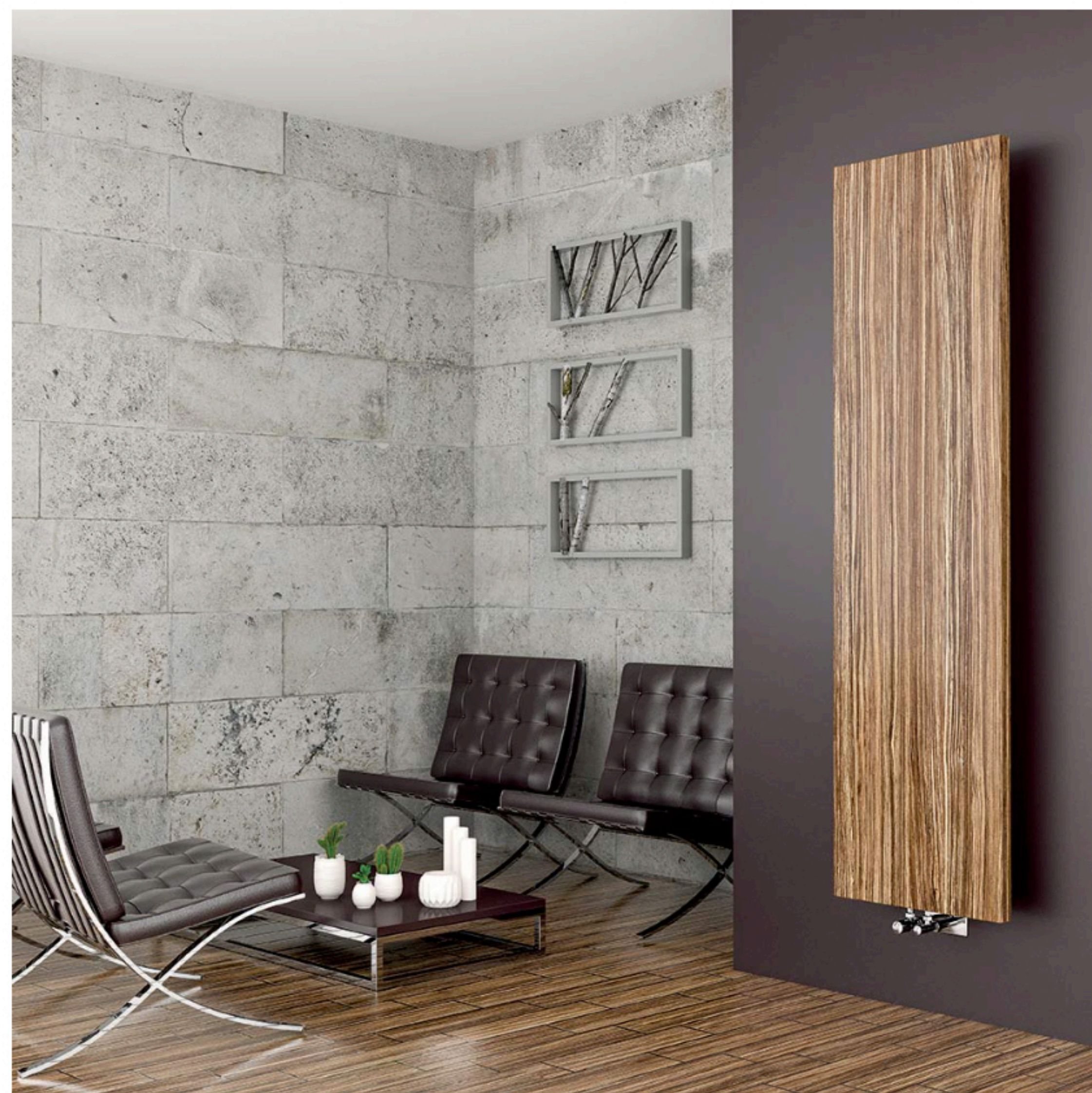
